

## WHAT TO EXPECT

Monday evening: 7.30pm – 8.30pm / 8.45pm – 9.45pm  
Up to 37 people in each session, recorded live on Zoom

- Please only attend a session you're signed up for. Your name will be marked off on arrival.
- If you feel at all unwell, however mild and un-Covid-like, please stay home.
- For track and trace purposes each register will be kept for 21 days. St Mark's also require visitors to scan the NHS App QR code on arrival (if you have the app.) but we shall keep our own records.
- If you forget your music, unfortunately you won't be able to share.
- You must wear a face covering unless you are exempt. You may remove it once in your seat.
- On arrival please wait outside the church until invited to enter through the usual entrance.
- WCS will provide hand sanitiser for use on entry and exit.
- Seats will be marked with a coloured card on alternate rows, and pews must be filled from the front.
- Please remain in your place throughout the rehearsal and please no mingling!
- Please bring your own drink if required and keep your possessions with you at your seat.
- The toilets will be open but please avoid using if you can.
- Due to requirements to keep the venue ventilated, with some of the external doors open, you may want to bring a warm layer if the weather gets cold.
- At the end of your session you will be directed to exit through another set of doors (that we don't usually use for rehearsal), leaving from the back rows first.
