
Here are the notes for our concert at Holy Trinity Church in Wandsworth this coming Saturday. If you have any questions, speak to your voice rep.

Thursday rehearsal

- Don't forget the rehearsal on Thursday 8 June, which is at St Marks from 7.30pm.

Concert venue

- Holy Trinity Church, Beaumont Rd, Wandsworth, London SW19 6SP; location **A** on map.



- If you are driving, there is free parking on Beaumont Road itself and streets to the east. Make sure you allow plenty of time to find a parking space and then get to the church.
- If you are coming by public transport, here are a few options:
 - 93 bus to Tibbetts Corner (location **B** on map); 11 minute walk to the church.
 - Tube etc. to Southfields (location **C** on map); 16 minute walk to the church.
 - 39 or 493 bus to Linstead Way (location **D**) on map; 2 minute walk to the church.

Changing rooms

- We have a good amount of space for changing in the church hall just next door.
 - Ladies will be on the top floor.
 - Gents will be on the floor below.
 - Don't bring more than the absolute minimum that you need.
 - The rooms are secure, but don't bring valuables if you don't have to.

Saturday afternoon rehearsal

- Please gather in the church, **ready to take your places at 1.40pm.**
- We will rehearse from **2.00pm to 4.30pm** with a break in the middle.
- **A note on seating:**
 - This is a new venue for us. It's not one of our biggest venues, but I promise that everyone will have a seat!

- Because I don't know exactly how I will arrange the chairs on the dais and the staging that we have hired, there won't be a detailed seating plan in advance – I will have to fine tune it on the day.
- Please make sure you arrive **on time by 1.40pm on Saturday** – that will give us plenty of time to arrange people on stage, optimise sight lines, etc.
- When we're getting on stage, I will be relying on your flexibility and good sense to move around if necessary so that we can make sure that everyone is comfortable, can see etc.

Concert dress

- Ladies: plain black full length skirts or trousers, black long- or ¾-sleeved tops.
- Gents: black DJ trousers, black open neck shirts.

Concert

- Dressed and **ready to go on stage by 5.45pm**.
- We will decide on procession details on Saturday afternoon.
- Concert starts at 6.00pm.
- Concert finishes at about 7.30pm.

Music return

- All borrowed scores must be returned:
 - On Monday 5 June if you are not singing in the concert.
 - After the concert on Saturday 10 June if you are singing in the concert.
 - By a colleague on your behalf.

- **Please please please try your very hardest to get the music to Vicky by the 10th**. She has a lot of sorting & returning to do in very short order before issuing the music for the G-Live concert.
