Getting to Cadogan Hall

The easiest way to travel to Cadogan Hall is by public transport. Located two minutes walk from Sloane Square underground station, served by the District and Circle lines, just one stop from Victoria station which has both mainline and additional underground connections.

Please allow adequate time when travelling to the venue – bag security searches may be in operation.

Underground

Sloane Square station (2 minutes' walk).

Upon exiting Sloane Square Station, turn immediately right, passing the Royal Court Theatre (you will see Cadogan Hall's tower in front of you). Cross over Cliveden Place and walk up Sedding Street to the Hall.

Bus

Sloane Street (1 minute's walk).

Frequent bus services stop in Sloane Square and neighbouring streets including King's Road, Sloane Street and Lower Sloane Street. Bus services include numbers 11, 19, 22, 137, 211, 319, 360, 452 and C1.
