We are working hard on Dvorak's Requiem with Daniel and our new accompanist Ben Giddens.

The world premiere of this Requiem was October 9 1891 during the Birmingham Music Festival with the composer conducting. The second was early in 1892 in Manchester. Music critics greeted it as one of the most powerful settings of the Mass for the Dead.

It is beautiful as well as powerful. We hope you are joining us, on November 15 at 7:30 pm, to hear OUR performance in the majesty of Southwark Cathedral.
