Comments can be attributed, or anonymous, as suits you.

2026/27 Season Dates for your Diary:

October 22: we record Critical Mass, by Tarik O'Regan, at St Augustine's Church in Kilburn.

November 14 at 1930: we sing a programme of Argentinian music. at Southwark Cathedral. Martin Palmeri composed Misa a Buenos Aires (or Misatango) a setting of the mass in Latin with music in tango style scored for mixed choir, bandoneon ensemble (type of concertina), piano and strings. Lamentaciones de Jeremias Propheta, by Alberto Ginastera, was written in the USA as he was dismissed from his teaching post by the Peron regime. It comprises three movements in Latin sung unaccompanied.

December 12: our Carol Concerts (1530 & 1800) will be performed at St Paul's Church in Southfields. These are always popular and often sold out.

March 6: Beethoven died 1827. WCS is organizing a Come & Sing of his Mass in C at St Mark's Church in Wimbledon. Come and Sing? Come and Listen? More data will follow.

April 10: both works in our Spring Concert at the Cadogan Hall marked Beethoven's death. Cherubini's Requiem in C was sung at his funeral and Libera Me by Ignaz von Seyfried a short time thereafter.

May 8: In 2017 Wimbledon Choral, in association with the Merton Music Foundation started SingFest as an outreach activity to bring together Singers of all ages and capabilities across the Borough for a day of shared singing. It is free and it is fun. Please come and join us if you can.

I hope you have a wonderful summer and look forward to seeing you in November.
